

Question: How do I find the average salary/top hiring companies for all majors?

1. Login (using OSU username and password) to Fisher Career Data Central by going to the following link and selecting BSBA: <https://fisher-osu.12twenty.com/start>
2. From the Fisher Career Data Central Homepage, click on “Learn More”.
